**AGREED ORDER FORFEITING WEAPON – WEAPON IN CUSTODY OF LAW ENFORCEMENT EVIDENCE**

On this date the State of Texas, the Defendant, Zion Isaiah Singleton and Defendant’s attorney of record, as part of the negotiated disposition in this case, appeared and moved this court to order the forfeiture of the weapon(s) owned by the Defendant and described below to the following law enforcement agency: Austin Police Department, to hold the same, for **destruction only**. The law enforcement agency is to destroy the weapon(s), along with any seized ammunition, unless the law enforcement agency has verified that the weapon is stolen and identified the rightful owner (including through a proceeding conducted pursuant to Chapter 47 of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure); alleged to have been used in a separate criminal matter; in dispute or evidence in a civil proceeding; or evidence in an ongoing criminal investigation or prosecution. This Order is given full force and effect whether the weapon is in the possession of the aforementioned agency or a different one.


